**Trained Leaders** – It looks like Scouting Leaders are not getting the training required for their positions. Perhaps they were trained in their prior position. When one moves to a new position in Scouting, two things need to happen: 1) Fill out a new Adult Application for the new position, and 2) Take the Leader Specific Training course for your new position. You may also begin filling out your completion of requirements to earn your “Training Knot”.
