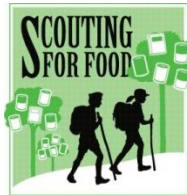
Popcorn money is due tonight. Lets close the books and receive your commission.

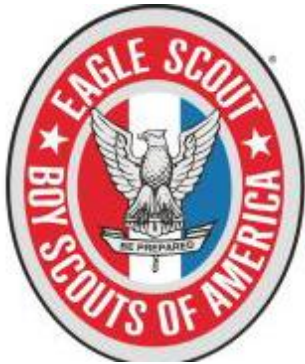
Friends of Scouting: Goal \$28,000 Actual \$29,873 or 106.7% of Goal. Thank you so much El Capitan, you are all doing a great job.
